

2020 The Safe Installation of Energy-Efficient Propane Appliances Program HVAC / Plumber Information

To participate in the program, you must be a licensed plumber / HVAC company

THIS PROGRAM RUNS ON A CALENDAR YEAR January 1, 2020 — December 31, 2020

The safety inspection MUST be completed by the Propane provider on ALL applications, and your FEIN, Plumbers Licence or Tax ID number must be on the application or on your invoice.

Any safety inspection that cannot be completed and at the IPGA office by December 31, 2020; it should be held over for the 2021 program.

Example: New propane appliance was installed on December 15th, the safety inspection was completed on December 30th, the application must be faxed or emailed or postmarked on or before December 31, 2020 to qualify for 2020 funds.

Overview

The incentive for the HVAC Company or Plumber is to help guide the Sales agent to promote propane to the customer when they are choosing a water heater. This program establishes an incentive for new energy-efficient propane appliances that are safely installed. Eligible new propane appliances: will replace an existing electric, fuel oil, natural gas or propane standard, tankless or power vent water heater with a new propane standard, tankless or power vent water heater; or are installed in new home construction; or are installed in new manufactured homes. The program will reimburse the customer and HVAC / Plumber for safe installation of approved energy-efficient propane appliances in the amounts listed below:

The customer will receive a rebate of:

•	Power Vent Water Heater	\$ 300.00	(This Program Starts 1/1/2020)
•	Tankless Water Heater	\$ 300.00	(This Program Starts 1/1/2020)
•	Standard Water Heater	\$ 200.00	(This Program Starts 1/1/2020)

<u>AND</u>

The HVAC / Plumber will receive an Incentive of:

•	Standard Water Heater	\$ 200.00	(This Program Starts 1/1/2020)
•	Tankless Water Heater	\$ 300.00	(This Program Starts 1/1/2020)
•	Power Vent Water Heater	\$ 300.00	(This Program Starts 1/1/2020)

EXCEPTION: The incentive is not for Propane to Propane replacements)

A maximum of \$400.00 per residence may be claimed per year

Homeowners, builders, and sales agents of manufactured home dealers can participate in the program. The person applying to the program is called the *applicant*. Reimbursements for safe installations are paid by the IPGA to the applicant.

To qualify for this program, an application must be made on the forms provided by the IPGA. All requested information must be provided along with the necessary documentation.
